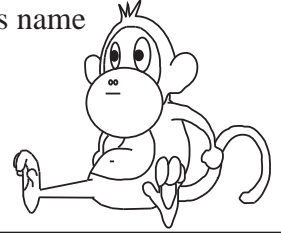

What to where to camp (it may seem complicated but it's really just common sense)

SHOES: Comfortable for walking! we do walk to our field trips so it is important that the kids wear shoes that are comfortable for walking (no flip-flops, cowboy boots, ugg boots...) but they will also be wearing shoes in the sand when the sand gets hot in the afternoon (not while they are playing, while they are walking back from the ocean) CROCS are GREAT for the beach days!

Swimsuits: Of course, the kids should wear swimsuits under whatever they wear to camp. The kids will be given the opportunity to change into dry clothes before they are picked up at 2. (although the kids will not be in the water above their ankles they some how manage to get very wet)

Hats and T-shirts: the kids will be given official camp hats and shirts on the first day. It is extremely important that they wear them on the field trip days (Tuesday and Thursday) as they identify us as a group.

COLD WEATHER: Camp will be ON rain or shine! So if it looks like rain please dress them warm but still have them pack beach clothes since very often it may be foggy in the morning and then 80 degrees by 10am. If it is too cold or rainy to go to the beach I do have indoor activities for us but we may also make the short walk up to third st to see our movie to escape the rain.

In 13 years of camp it has only rained once and we walked up to third st. and it was the kids favorite thing ever!

Lunch: please try to pack a TRASHLESS LUNCH!
Drop Off Instructions:

You will be dropping your children off each morning at 1339 PCH. (if you are coming from the North side of Santa Monica, take the California incline down to PCH and make a left. Follow the #'s to 1339, about 2 blocks NORTH of the Peir) This is a highway SO PLEASE DO NOT STOP ABRUPTLY OR DOUBLE PARK. It is perfectly safe as long as you follow these instructions.

I like to stagger the drop off and pick time to avoid congestion on the highway. Girls get dropped off at 8:55 and picked up at 2:25. Boys get dropped off at 9:05 and picked up at 2:35. If you are carpooling with girls and boys come right at 9 and 2:30. You can pull into my neighbors driveways but DO NOT get out of your car if you are blocking someone's driveway.

You should expect the kids to be sandy when you pick them up (that is a sign that we had fun that day!). we do our best to knock all the sand off the kids but after a day at the beach some residual sand is inevitable! so if you have really nice seats or just had your car detailed you may want to lay some towels down.

I WILL BE OUTSIDE GREETING THE KIDS AND WALKING THEM INTO THE BACKYARD OF THE HOUSE WHERE THEY WILL BE MET BY THE OTHER 3 COUSELOURS.

Please inform me if your child is NOT coming to camp on a field trip day so that we do not waste time waiting for them.

What to bring each day:

Please apply sunscreen to your child BEFORE they come to camp each day. We will reapply at lunch time.

PLEASE PACK A Lunch/Snack/BIG PLASTIC BOTTLE OF Water! I will keep the kids hydrated!

Toys: I have all the beach toys we need but if your child wants to bring something they are more than welcome as long as they are going to be able to share that item with other campers... Please do not bring anything that you are REALLY attached to or do not want to get sandy!

carpooling to camp is a GREAT idea! the kids love arriving together and it is a lot easier for everyone. If you already know a classmate or friend going to camp please try to arrange a carpool. Some families work it out so that one family drops off and the other picks up...

I will be emailing you the SPECIFICS of camp (what to bring, wear, drop off and pick up instructions...)

I just wanted to fill you in about safety at Monkey Camp. Safety is of course our top priority.

I have a \$2 million insurance policy with Farmers Insurance. So rules like "no swimming" are not negotiable.

Our walking field trips are very safe. To get to 3rd St. we only cross 2 intersections. To get to the bowling alley we walk along the beach and only cross 2 intersections. The kids will NEVER be allowed to go to the bathroom without an adult.
